### What is the Women's Information Centre (CID)?

It is a free and specialized service of the Women's Institute of the Balearic Islands that offers information, guidance and advice in person, by telephone or by telematic means on the following areas:

- n **Legal area:** civil law, criminal law, administrative law, labour law, legal aid, etc.
- n **Social Area:** provision of primary and specific social services, health, housing, etc.
- n **Labour Area:** training-labour resources of the community, creation of companies, self-employment, harassment in the workplace, etc.
- n **Gender-based violence:** how to intervene in a situation of violence, denunciation, protection measures, rights of victims and their children, specific community resources, etc.

### Training

Information and/or training sessions for professionals and other groups in matters related to women: specific resources, equality, regulations, etc.

### Addressed people

- n Women resident in the Balearic Islands
- n Women who are victims of gender-based violence and/or their family members and/or friends
- n Professionals of the different fields of intervention: social, health, education, policial, legal, etc.
